### ACTIVITIES

Monthly meetings/talks/demonstrations are given by practising potters, art historians and artists. London, with its many galleries and museums, exerts a powerful influence on the members of London Potters; the continuing presence of major ceramicists now joined by a younger generation, ensures that London Potters is an alive and stimulating organisation. ### EXHIBITIONS

There is an established programme of special exhibitions whose aim is to present and display the work of London Potters in order to promote the professional status of the ceramicist and to create a wider appreciation of the craft. All work is for sale.

All members receive a colour bi-monthly newsletter with features on the work of members and information about meetings, events, exhibitions and other opportunities. Contributions are welcome.
